SUBJECT	Agenda Item #14(b)(3)(B) – SB 1033 (Hill) Medical Board: Disclosure of Probationary Status

## Background:

The bill would have required the Medical Board of California, the Osteopathic Medical Board of California, the California Board of Podiatric Medicine, the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners, the Naturopathic Medicine Committee, and the Acupuncture Board by July 1, 2018, to develop a standardized format for listing specified information related to the probation of a licensee and to provide that information to an inquiring member of the public, on any documents informing the public of probation orders, and on a specified profile Internet Web page of each licensee subject to probation.

Staff reached out to Senator Hill's office and the Business and Professions Committee to see if this bill will be pursued again next year. Both are unsure and stated they will discuss it in the beginning of the next legislative year.

Status: Dead, failed to pass off of the Senate Floor.
