SUBJECT	Agenda Item #14(b)(3)(D) – SB 1155 (Morrell) Professions and Vocations: Licenses: Military

Background:

This bill, on and after January 1, 2018, would have required every board within the Department of Consumer Affairs to grant a fee waiver for the application for and the issuance of an initial license to an applicant who supplies satisfactory evidence, as defined, to the board that the applicant has served as an active duty member of the California National Guard or the United States Armed Forces and was honorably discharged. The bill would have required that a veteran be granted only one fee waiver, except as specified.

Staff contacted Senators Morrell's office and they are going to decide whether or not to pursue it again next year at their January meeting.

Status: Dead, this bill was held in the Assembly Committee on Appropriations on the Suspense File.
