

NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS

October 17, 2014

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8 (c), and Section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Board of Psychology is providing notice of changes made to proposed Examination regulation which does the following:

Amend Sections 1388 (a), 1388 (b), 1388 (c), 1388 (e), 1388 (f), 1388 (g), 1388 (h), 1388.6 (a), 1388.6 (b), 1388.6 (c), 1388.6 (d), 1388.6 (e), 1388.6 (f), 1389 (a), and 1392, 1392 (b), 1392 (c), 1392 (d), 1392 (e), and 1392 (f). These sections are contained within Title, 16 California Code of Regulations and cover the examination requirements of candidates for licensure.

These changes are in response to the discovery of errors in the proposed language previously submitted to the Office of Administrative Law.
