

NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS

October 17, 2014

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8 (c), and Section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Board of Psychology is providing notice of modifications made to the text of a proposed regulatory change that renumbers Section 1397.12 as Section 1395.2, and amends Title 16, CCR Section 1395.2 to revise the Board's disciplinary guidelines to incorporate the Department of Consumer Affairs' Uniform Standards for Substance Abusing Licensees, to now be entitled "Disciplinary Guidelines and Uniform Standards Related to Substance Abusing Licensees," (Amended 9/14), and to now be included within Article 7, Standards Related to Denial, Discipline, and Reinstatement of Licenses or Registrations.

NOTICE IS ALSO GIVEN that the following document is being added to the rulemaking record for the regulatory proceeding concerning section 1395.2 of Title 16, CCR: "Disciplinary Guidelines and Uniform Standards Related to Substance Abusing Licensees" (Amended 9/14).
