Subject Enforcement Program Statistics

Please find attached the Overview of Enforcement Activity, displaying Complaint, Investigation, and Discipline statistics for the previous five fiscal years, and the current fiscal year to date. Below is a summary of the program's trends for fiscal year 2012/13:

Complaints

The total number of complaints received for fiscal year 2012/13 is 707, averaging approximately 59 per month. Board staff completed 535 desk investigations with an average processing time of 32 days. 87 formal investigations were completed with an average processing time of 374 days.

Formal Discipline

Currently there are 57 cases pending at the Attorney General's Office. Those cases include Accusations, Accusation and Petition to Revoke Probation, and Statement of Issues (License Denial). The fiscal year ended with 29 formal discipline actions which represent 4% of the total complaints received.

Probation

Board staff is currently monitoring 32 probationers. Of the 32 probationers, 12 are subject to fluid testing.

Consumer Protection Enforcement Initiative (CPEI) Audit

In August, the Executive Officer, Thomas O'Connor, and I met with Department of Consumer Affairs Deputy Director of Enforcement, Michael Gomez, and a representative from the Department of Finance (DOF) on the first phase of a comprehensive audit of CPEI positions.

During the meeting, Mr. O'Connor and I provided an overview of the enforcement program improvements in terms of reduced intake and desk investigation processing times due in large part to CPEI staffing increases. Other improvements include revising our initial contact letters to licensees, establishing processing time expectations for staff, and improved monitoring of cases assigned for expert review. We provided feedback on the need to dedicate resources to focus on reducing the processing times for formal investigation and the discipline process. In September, Board staff completed and submitted an extensive survey of the enforcement program to the DOF. DOF indicated they will be considering how CPEI positions are utilized, along with reviewing specific classifications used to perform enforcement-related work, and the resulting productivity from these positions.
