### **Proposed Amendments to Title 16, CCR Section 1397.12 – Uniform Standards Related to Substance Abuse and Disciplinary Guidelines**

The Board voted at its October 2012 meeting to update the Disciplinary Guidelines Related to Substance Abusing Licensees to include Sexual Orientation Change Efforts (SOCE) as unprofessional conduct pursuant to SB 1172 (Lieu) – Sexual Orientation Change Efforts (SOCE), Chapter 835, Statutes of 2012.

The following changes have been incorporated into the Disciplinary Guidelines and Uniform Standards Related to Substance Abusing Licensees:

#### **865.1, 865.2 SEXUAL ORIENTATION CHANGE EFFORTS**

MAXIMUM : Revocation; denial of license or registration.

MINIMUM: Revocation stayed, 5 year probation, psychological evaluation and/or therapy if appropriate (2) and (7), California Psychology Law and Ethics Examination (CPLEE) (8), education review(14), and standard terms and conditions 15-31.
