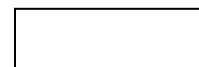

- Oct. 2 Non-urgency bills enacted on or before this date take effect January 1, 2015. (Art. IV, Sec. 8(c)).
- Nov. 4 General Election.
- Nov. 30 Adjournment *sine die* at midnight (Art. IV, Sec. 3(a)).
- Dec. 1 2015-16 Regular Session convenes for Organizational Session at 12 noon. (Art. IV, Sec. 3(a)).
