SUBJECT	- SB 272 (Hertzberg) The California Public Records Act: Local Agencies: Inventory – Consideration of Committee Recommendation to Watch

Background:

-SB 272 (Hertzberg) The California Public Records Act: Local Agencies: Inventory

SUMMARY: This bill would require each local agency, in implementing the California Public Records Act, to create a catalog of enterprise systems, as defined, to make the catalog publicly available upon request in the office of the clerk of the agency's legislative body, and to post the catalog on the local agency's Internet Web site. The bill would require the catalog to disclose a list of the enterprise systems utilized by the agency, and, among other things, the current system vendor and product. Because the bill would require local agencies to perform additional duties, it would impose a state-mandated local program.

LOCATION: 05/07/2015 SENATE Read third time. Passed. (Ayes 37. Noes 0.) Ordered to the Assembly.
