SUBJECT	- SB 468 (Hill) Bureau of Security and Investigative Services: licensees – Consideration of Committee Recommendation to Watch

Background:

-SB 468 (Hill) Bureau of Security and Investigative Services: licensees.

SUMMARY: Existing law requires the Bureau of Security and Investigative Services to issue a firearms permit to a private patrol operator when specified conditions are satisfied, including that the bureau has determined, after investigation, that the carrying and use of a firearm by the applicant, in the course of his or her duties, presents no apparent threat to the public safety.

This bill would require an applicant to undergo a psychological evaluation, reviewed by a licensed psychologist shall be of the applicant's choice, in order to certify the applicant's psychological capability to exercise appropriate judgment, restraint, and self-control, as provided.
