SUBJECT	AB 19 (Chang) State Government: Regulations – Consideration of Committee Recommendations - Watch

Background:

-AB 19 (Chang) Governor's Office of Business and Economic Development: small business: regulations.

SUMMARY: This bill would require the Governor's Office of Business and Economic Development, in consultation with the advocate, to establish a process for the ongoing review of existing regulations. The bill would require the review to be primarily focused on regulations affecting small businesses adopted prior to January 1, 2016, to determine whether the regulations could be less administratively burdensome or costly to affected sectors. The bill would require the office to submit the results of its review, including its conclusions and recommendations, to the agency with jurisdiction over the reviewed regulations and to post the same information on its Internet Web site. This bill would require the Governor's Office of Business and Economic Development, under the direction of in consultation with the advocate, to establish a process for the ongoing review of existing regulations.
