SUBJECT	-AB 259 (Dababneh) Personal Information: Privacy – Consideration of Committee Recommendations - Watch

Background:

-AB 259 (Dababneh) Personal Information: Privacy

SUMMARY: Existing law requires an agency that owns or licenses computerized data that includes personal information, as defined, to provide notification of any breach in the security of that data to any California resident whose personal information may have been compromised by the breach, as specified.

This bill would additionally require an agency, if the agency was the source of the breach and the breach compromised a person's social security number, driver's license number, or California identification card number, to offer to provide the person with identity theft prevention and mitigation services at no cost for not less than 12 months, as specified.
