- 6/17/16 – California Psychology Internship Council (CAPIC) Quarterly Board of Directors Meeting – Karen Johnson. The Board's statutes and regulations allow for the accrual of supervised professional experience in formal internship placements and formal postdoctoral training programs which are members of CAPIC. Many questions that the Board receives from its licensees, applicants, and trainees are regarding the requirements governing the accrual and verification of supervised experience required for licensure as a psychologist. The regulations regarding the accrual of supervised professional experience are very complex, and the Board is currently changing the way that supervised professional experience is verified to the Board. Making a presentation at this meeting would be of great benefit, as Ms. Johnson would be presenting directly to the training programs. This information can then be disseminated directly to the supervisors and trainees who are currently participating in predoctoral and postdoctoral placements to help them better understand the requirements of qualifying supervision experience and help prevent the denial of years of training.
