SUBJECT	Agenda Item #4(o) – SB 1195 (Hill) Professions and Vocations: Board Actions

Background:

This bill provides requirements and procedures for the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs to review a decision or other action by a board under the Department regarding a restraint or licensee and adds competitive impact as a standard when reviewing regulatory actions of a state board. It prohibits the Board of Registered Nursing's Executive Officer from being a licensee of the Board. It authorizes a veterinary technician to compound a drug for anesthesia for animals in licensed premises, and extends the Veterinary Medical Board's Sunset Bill.
