<b>SUBJECT</b>	Agenda Item #14(a)(3)(B) – AB 2443 (Baker) Local Control and Accountability Plans (Improving Mental Health Access for Students)

**Background:**

This bill relates to Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) by the governing board of a school district. This bill would have required a description of the annual goals to be achieved for each of the state's delineated priorities for all pupils and certain subgroups of pupils and add to those factors the number of practicing school psychologists working on school climate issues.

At the May Board Meeting, the Board took a "Support" position on AB 2443 (Baker). On May 24, 2016, the Board sent a letter of support to the Assembly Committee on Appropriations.

This bill was held in the Assembly Committee on Appropriations in the Suspense File due to potential significant costs to the General Fund.

**Status:** Dead, this bill was held by the Assembly Committee on Appropriations.
