<b>SUBJECT</b>	Agenda Item #5(b)(2)(AAA) – ACR 8 (Jones-Sawyer) Adverse Childhood Experiences: Post-Traumatic “Street” Disorder

**Background:**

This measure would recognize adverse childhood experiences (ACEs), also known as post-traumatic "street" disorder in communities of color, as having lasting negative outcomes to both physical and mental health with growing implications for California.

On July 13, the bill was amended to remove reference to ACEs as a mental health condition.
