Attached is section 2982 of Business and Professions Code with the recommended changes.

Action

Discussion and consideration of revising section 2982 psychology license renewal period to the last date of a two-year period from initial issuance date.

1 Expiration of License/Birth Date Renewal

3 § 2982. All licenses expire and become invalid at 12 midnight on the last day of
4 February, 1980, and thereafter shall expire at 12 midnight of the last date of a two-year
5 period from initial issuance date. ~~legal birth date of the licensee during the second year~~
6 ~~of a two-year term, if not renewed.~~

7 ~~The board shall establish by regulation procedures for the administration of~~
8 ~~the birth date renewal program, including but not limited to, the establishment of a pro~~
9 ~~rata formula for the payments of fees by licentiates affected by the implementation of~~
10 ~~that program and the establishment of a system of staggered license application dates~~
11 ~~such that a relatively equal number of licenses expire annually."~~

13 To renew an unexpired license, the licensee shall, on or before the date on which it
14 would otherwise expire, apply for renewal on a form provided by the board,
15 accompanied by the prescribed renewal fee.
