# Psychological Associates (2016 Sunset Conforming Changes) Advisory

**Purpose**: California Code of Regulations, Title 16, sections 1391.1, 1391.2, 1391.5, 1391.6, 1391.8, 1391.10, 1391.11, 1391.12, and 1392.1 were amended **effective July 1, 2023.** 

# **Summary of Changes:**

The regulations are updated to make conforming changes to the Business and Professions Code sections 2913 and 2987, implementing the requirement that the person responsible for the initial psychological associate registration, the registration renewal, and any changes in the registration status, is the psychological associate, and not the employer and/or primary supervisor.

## **Application Form:**

Individuals applying for a registration must use the required form PSB 100, entitled "Application For Registration As A Psychological Associate" (New 2023).

#### **Notification Form:**

## New applicants

Applicants must use form PSB 101, entitled "Notification To Add Or Change Supervisor Or Service Location For A Psychological Associate" (New 2023) if registering with more than one primary supervisor at the time of application.

# <u>Current registrants</u>

Registered psychological associates must use form PSB 101, entitled "Notification To Add Or Change Supervisor Or Service Location For A Psychological Associate" (New 2023), as follows:

- 1) To add or change a primary supervisor to be associated with a current registration
- 2) To remove a primary supervisor currently associated with a current registration within 30 days after termination of the supervision\*
- 3) To add or change the location where services are being rendered by a registered psychological associate with the same primary supervisor

\*The Board will no longer accept a report of termination of supervision from the primary supervisor(s). To avoid processing delays, it is recommended that primary supervisor(s) include completion of form PSB 101 (New 2023) as part of an exit interview for submission to the Board by the registered psychological associate.

#### Renewal:

Annual reports will no longer be required to complete the annual renewal for a registration.
