## DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS BOARD OF PSYCHOLOGY

## ORDER OF ADOPTION

Effective August 23, 2009 the Board amended Sections 1391.10 and 1391.12 of Division 13.1 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations, to read as follows:

## § 1391.10. Annual Reports.

On or before <del>January 31 of each year</del> the expiration of a registration, every supervisor of a psychological assistant shall submit to the <u>bB</u>oard on a form provided by the <u>bB</u>oard a report for the <del>preceding calendar year</del> registration period showing:

- (a) The nature of the psychological functions performed by the psychological assistant being supervised;
- (b) Certification of employment.
- (c) The locations at which the psychological assistant provided the psychological functions and the type, extent and amount of supervision.
- (d) A certification that the psychological functions performed by the psychological assistant were performed at a level satisfactory to ensure safety to the public.

## § 1391.12. Psychological Assistant Renewals.

- (a) A new registration shall expire one year after issuance. The registration of a psychological assistant shall be renewed by the employer no later than January 31 of each year annually, on or before its expiration.
- (b) Those A registrations renewed 30 days after the deadline its expiration must be accompanied by the delinquency fee required in section 1392.1 in order to be renewed.
- (c) A psychological assistant who has been registered with the <u>bBoard</u> but whose registration <u>has expired and</u> has not been renewed by the employer shall not function as a psychological assistant.
- (d) A psychological assistant employed and registered by more than one employer shall have his or her registration renewed by each employer.
- (e) Those A registrations not renewed within 60 days after the renewal date its expiration shall become void and a new application for registration shall be submitted by the employer.
